DOWNPATRICK breeder Harry Stewart and local flock owner William Tait swept the boards at the Suffolk Sheep Society (NI Branch) Northern Ireland Championships, which were held the 168th Omagh Show last weekend. Sponsored by the Northern Bank, the blue riband event of the Society's show calendar attracted a huge entry and a packed judging ring was enthralled as adjudicator Herbert Stanley meticulously selected each of the class winners. Burnview flock owners, S & W Tait captured the main rosettes in the shearling ram, ewe having reared lambs in 2008, ram lamb and group of three categories while the Castlewellan prefix of JH Stewart topped the honours in the shearling ewe and ewe lamb classes.

And it was the Co Down breeder's outstanding shearling ewe that went on to scoop the supreme championship with Tait's ram lamb, which had earlier held off the challenge of Mark Priestley, selected as reserve.

Other names to feature prominently in the rosettes were Gary Beacom, Norman Robinson, Ian Donald, Campbell and Jason Watson and Patrick Donnelly

Upwards on 90 entries contested the various categories with each of the class winners receiving 2.5 litres of Valbazen kindly sponsored by Pfizer representative, Frank McCrystal.
